

Odeefoo Education Fund supports final-year students

THE Odeefoo Oteng Korankye II Education Fund, a non-governmental organisation has disbursed GH¢8,250 to 11 final-year Senior High School (SHS) students as they return to school to prepare for their final

examination.

In addition, the students also received nose masks, provisions, alcohol-based hand sanitisers and other bursaries.

The support is to enable the students to buy some learning materials and also to help take care of their personal needs while they are in the school.

At a brief ceremony, the Founder of the fund, Odeefoo Oteng Korankye II, gave the assurance that the fund would continue to provide the basic needs of students.

He commended the

students for their improved academic performance over the period and called on them to study hard in order to excel in the exams to enable them gain admission to the university.

Odeefoo Korankye II, who is also the Chief of Berekuso, admonished the students to ensure that they complied with

all the protocols set out by the Ghana Education Service (GES) in order to stay safe from the virus.

He urged Ghanaians to wear the nose mask anytime they stepped out of their homes, "since that will help to stop the spread of the coronavirus."

Odeefoo Korankye II said with the increasing number of confirmed cases being recorded, there was a high possibility of the continuous spread of the virus and Ghanaians must practice responsible life by constantly following the COVID-19 protocols.

Responding on behalf of the beneficiaries, a General Science student of the Odorgonno SHS, Godwin Sallah, said they were grateful to the fund for the support granted them.
